The Muirfield Property Handbook: Located under *Publications*, this is an in-depth look at living in Muirfield; its history, concept, amenities, bylaws and policies.

Design Control Committee Guidelines and Applications: Located under *Design Review* are guidelines and applications for residents who desire to make external property changes. Forms can be downloaded and printed or filled out onscreen, then submitted to the Design Control Committee for consideration.

Members Area: View minutes, the resident directory, financial statements and annual meeting information, plus request firewood, mailbox repairs, an architect visit, and more! Click the white button in the upper right-hand corner of any page to get to the Members Area. Sign up is necessary but is free.

e-News: e-News emails come out several times a month to residents and includes Association announcements plus news from Muirfield organizations, the City of Dublin, and the community. e-News will be sent to the email address we have on file for you, but if you missed an issue, you may view recent emails online under the *News* section.

Calendar: The Muirfield calendar lists Association meetings, MVCA activities, swim meets, the pool schedule, tennis programs schedule, and other events of interest to our residents. Located under *News*.

Swim and Tennis Information: During the season, click the *Swimming* or *Tennis* button in the upper right hand corner of any page. View swim and tennis program information, hours, and locations.

Articles of Incorporation and By-Laws: Discover how Muirfield Village came to exist and the responsibilities of the Board of Directors. Located in the *Publications* section.

Declaration: The Warranty Deed is the backbone of our community. It outlines the community as a Planned Unit Development, including its rules and restrictions. Located in the *Publications* section.
