2016 ANNUAL MEETING

Road and Bike Path Construction Updates

Hooray! We can pretty much use the 270 and 33 interchange again, in all directions and with all ramps! After serious rain delays in June and July, the blockade of 33 over 270 was removed in mid-December and the interchange, while many months from completion, at least functions again.

By October-November of 2016, the new flyover ramps and tunnel will all be completed, the concrete panels with reliefs of Dublin scenes and Celtic knots will be visible to passers-by, we will no longer have dangerous weaving of traffic, and we may even have the landscaping done. It really wasn't too bad, less of a hassle to work around than many of us feared. So, by the end of this year, orange barrels gone, project complete!

CAC Chair Bob Fathman reports that the large new roundabout on the east side of the river will also be in full operation by the end of this year, allowing entrance and exit in all four directions, with the southbound-only underpass at the bridge preserved. Some finishing touches and landscaping may carry over to 2017, but just minor items.

The bike path along Glick is programed in the budget to complete in 2016, but there are a couple of sticking points in

THE BOUNCE CLUB FAMILY EVENT

MVCA has scheduled a winter family event at The Bounce Club in Powell, an indoor trampoline park, on Friday February 26th from 1-3 PM. Dublin City Schools will be closed that day and it's a great opportunity to get the kids out of the house and let them have fun with friends.

We have a limit on the number of jumpers allowed, so you need to make reservations if you are planning on attending. The cost is \$10 per jumper for an hour of jumping (\$4 off the regular price).

When we have all names and ages of jumpers, we will divide them into two groups so that younger kids jump from 1-2 PM and the older kids jump during 2-3 PM.



land acquisition, with the City filing for eminent domain for easement rights at the time of this writing. Stay tuned.

You will notice some signage coming up along the Muirfield Drive bike lanes that will more clearly designate those as intended for bicycle use.

And finally, in 2016 engineering studies will complete, as will land acquisition, for a new roundabout at Brand Rd. and Avery, with construction to begin and complete in 2017. Engineering and land acquisition will also occur this year for a double roundabout on Avery-Muirfield at both Perimeter and Perimeter Loop. Construction on those will not begin until 2018.
